7. Player Clearances and Foreign Player Licences

Any person registered with a previous or current CBL or NBL team must first obtain a player clearance from the team with which he is registered currently before being eligible to register as a playing member of any other team. Attached is the form that must be signed by both teams and then forwarded to BBNZ.

A restricted overseas player must obtain a Foreign Player Licence before taking the court. Attached is the form that must be completed and all information provided so that the application can be processed by BBNZ and then forwarded to FIBA Oceania for approval.

8. Rules and Regulations

The CBL will be run in accordance with BBNZ Internal Regulations and FIBA Rules including the CBL regulations listed below:

1.1. *NEW ZEALAND PLAYER*

A New Zealand Player shall include or be deemed to include:

1.1.1. A New Zealand Player shall be one who has New Zealand citizenship.

1.1.2. All New Zealand players participating in the NBL, and are under the age of 23 as at 31 December of that calendar year, will be classed as a non restricted player regardless of minutes played. The CBL team must represent the same region as the NBL team for which they played in that calendar year.

1.2. *RESTRICTED PLAYER*

1.2.1. A Restricted Overseas Player shall be one who is not a New Zealand Player as define in Rule 7.5.

1.2.2. A copy of the Foreign Player Licence must be lodged with the League Manager.

1.2.3. A Restricted New Zealand Player shall be one who has an NBL average court time, for the current season, of fifteen (15) minutes or more per game played by the player as compiled and confirmed by the NBL Office.

1.2.4. Each team shall be allowed a maximum of one (1) Restricted Player.

9. Team Uniform Colours

Team A – 1st team named (light uniforms)

Team B – 2nd team named (dark uniforms) or if teams can come to an agreement

10. Team Benches

Team A - left of score bench

Team B - right of score bench

11. Medical Facilities

Ice and first aid kit is available at the stadium. Ice will only be issued for on court injuries. Teams must provide their own ice for pre-existing injuries.

12. Warm Up

Teams are guaranteed a minimum of 10 minutes to warm up before tip off to your game. Please make sure your team is ready to take the court on time.

13. Changing Rooms

There are changing rooms at each stadium. Teams can either utilise the changing rooms or arrive at the stadium ready to play. Please note; the changing rooms will be utilised by other personnel within the stadium, so please keep team meetings to your accommodation or

another area of the stadium. Do not leave any gear in the changing rooms; Basketball New Zealand will not be held responsible if items are stolen or misplaced.

14. Judicial Committee/Procedure

The BBNZ Internal Regulations will be used.
