



Development Cluster Camp 1 – 15 or 16 May 2010

Development Cluster Camps are run by Basketball New Zealand to provide regional development and talent identification opportunities for players, coaches and support staff.



Information

Cluster Camps form a key part of BBNZ's player, coach and support staff pathway providing opportunities for identification on a national level. Cluster Camps are the entry point for the BBNZ programmes and are for 'identified' athletes only. The first Cluster Camp for 2010 will take place on **Saturday 15 or Sunday 16 May**.

Who attends

Players who have been identified within a Basketball New Zealand or Association programme and who exhibit the potential to play above Association level and are seeking to be involved in BBNZ's Player Development Programmes. These athletes should be nominated by a Basketball New Zealand coach and/or endorsed Association coach.

Cluster Camps are also open to **ALL** coaches and support staff looking for further development opportunities and/or exposure to BBNZ activities.

Links to 2011 Koru Development Tour

Athletes will be identified to attend the 2011 Koru Tour from the Cluster Camps programme.

Players and coaches seeking to be part of the Koru Development Tour to Australia in 2011 should attend and must nominate their availability for selection. This tour is to Australia and is scheduled for January 11-24, 2011 and will cost approx \$3,000. However the Cluster Camp programme is NOT limited to Koru Tour trialists. Athletes unable to participate on the Koru tour are still encouraged to attend.
