



EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

BBNZ is now seeking expressions of interest for the 2012 Tall Ferns' Manager position.

2012 is a significant year for the Tall Ferns. The team will travel to the Olympic Qualification Tournament in Turkey, and if successful in gaining a top five finish, carry on to the 2012 London Olympics. The 2012 programme is still being finalised but an approximate schedule is below:

All candidates for national team roles must possess the following general attributes:

- A member in good standing in the basketball community
- Excellent communication and team building skills
- A willingness to share information and experiences with other members of the basketball community
- Actively pursuing other opportunities for professional development
- Committed and enthusiastic to be involved in BBNZ programmes and displaying loyalty to BBNZ, the national team programme and personnel
- Will act as a positive ambassador and spokesperson for BBNZ
- A willingness to contribute to BBNZ development initiatives and underpinning programmes (clinics, workshops, camps etc.)

Managers must possess the following attributes:

- Understanding of international basketball and/or sport and demands placed on athletes, coaches and teams at the international level
- Sound administration and budgetary skills adhering to all BBNZ policies and procedures
- Excellent organisation and interpersonal skills as well as creative thinking skills
- Strong verbal and written communication skills
- Ability to handle multiple tasks simultaneously and prioritises appropriately in a fast paced environment
- Manages people to satisfactorily execute programme requirements and special events
- Experience travelling internationally and adaptable in dealing with different cultures and customs
- Managers are also expected to be able to transport, therefore, must have a current "Full" driver's license
